

Your Guide to the IBEW Local 353 Mental Wellness Benefits

When it comes to your mental, physical, or financial health, it takes work to build a healthy lifestyle. But you don't have to do it alone. As a member of the IBEW Local 353 you have a variety of mental health resources at your fingertips. In the same way you take care of your physical wellness, it's important to take care of your mental wellness, too. The IBEW Local 353 Benefit Plan has mental health coverage for when you or your eligible dependents need it. Using mental health services doesn't impact funds available to use for other types of paramedical services. Below are some helpful resources you can use to support an issue or a challenge you or a loved one might be facing.

Mental Wellness Benefit

As part of your IBEW Local 353 Benefit Plan, your Mental Wellness Benefit is currently reimbursed at 100% (limited to reasonable and customary charges) to a maximum of \$3,000 per calendar year, per covered person for all mental wellness practitioners combined. Mental health practitioners must be registered with their profession's regulatory or governing body in the province where services are provided. Here is the list of practitioners you have access to as part of your benefit plan:

- Registered Clinical Psychologist
- Intensive Behavioural Intervention (IBI)
- Registered Psychotherapist
- Registered Social Worker

Disability and Mental Wellness

Access to income replacement for total disability is included with your benefit plan and it not only covers physical injuries, but also mental health issues that prevent you from working. Coverage is there so you can worry less about missing work and focus on your recovery.

Help is there when you need it. If you're unable to work due to a mental health issue, contact the union hall at 416-510-3530 to request a disability package and remember to see a medical doctor as soon as possible. Disability benefits provide eligible members of IBEW Local 353 with partial income replacement while you are recovering from a totally disabling injury or illness and are unable to work.
